

Residential Maintenance Free Belt & Deck

The belt and deck on the Vision Fitness T9200/T9250/T9500/T9550/T9600 residential treadmills have been upgraded to a proprietary Maintenance-Free system.

Feature: Maintenance-Free System

Benefit: Our testing found that our new wax system lasts about 3X longer than our current system, 4,000 hours or 20,000 miles (@ 5mph)

Feature: Proprietary pre-waxed belts

Benefit: No more wax clumping up on rollers. This system allows for a higher melting point of the wax which keeps the wax in place and lasts longer.

Q: Are all residential treadmill currently shipping with the pre-waxed belts?

A: Yes

Q: Is there any wax on the deck?

A: No. The wax is on the belt.

Q: Is the wax different then what's on the Vision Fitness commercial treadmills?

A: The wax is the same. T9800 uses waxed belt and deck. T9700 uses wax on deck only.

Q: Can we add wax manually to the treadmills?

A: Adding wax manually is NOT recommended, the wax will clump up on the rollers and to the bottom side of the belt and cause noise and feel bumpy.

Q: What will happen if silicone is added to the treadmill?

A: The belt and deck will be wrecked and need to be replaced. The silicone will bond to the wax and create a gummy mixture that will eventually break the entire drive system.

Q: If a deck and belt needs to be replaced on a older treadmill will we send the new maintenance free belts?

A: We will continue to send out the old belts for old equipment until we exhaust our inventory.

Commercial Maintenance Free Belt and Deck

The new belt and deck system on the Vision Fitness T9700 and T9800 features a proprietary waxing system that is proven in high use commercial environments. On both models, the deck has a wax treatment and deck preparation that allows for a higher melting point of the wax resulting in longer lasting lubrication. In multiple field tests this system lasted over 25,000 miles. In addition to the new wax treatment on the deck, the T9800 contains a waxed belt to further increase the durability of the system.

When did these changes take place?

Many of these belt and deck changes were made months ago. We have been waiting for all the information before releasing the news. Please review your inventory and floor models. The serial number will indicate whether the product is a MAINTENANCE FREE product.
